Her youngest son John, and his wife CJ, beat a regular path through the woods, sharing many a chuckle over the antics of all family members, and spearheading annual trips to Kiawah Island to visit Alice's favorite vacation spot: the beach!

Her grandson Sam, and his wife Jerilyn, supplied her with another delight - great-grandsons Michael, James, and Christopher; plus the newest member expected to join the

family in May: little Alice Clarissa, the first Crenshaw-born girl in six generations, and aptly named after her great-grandmother.

Her grandson John Mark made her chuckle on a regular basis as they shared a similar sense of humor.

Her grandson Stephen made multiple pizza runs for her over the years, and kept her guessing about whether or not he would be wearing shoes as he walked his dog, Snacks, by their house every day for the last few years.

Last, but by no means least, the plethora of much-loved cousins, nieces, and nephews meant bustling, crowded tables at the holidays, and annual beach trips to Fernandina.

Alice anticipated with great excitement the day she was to be reunited with her parents, brother, and sister-in-law, and cousins who had gone before her to Glory.
