Dr. David Joseph Pasquariello, age 62, passed away August 4, 2017, following complications from heart surgery. Dr. Pasquariello was a beloved Chiropractor in the Mableton area for over 35 years. His patients were his passion, and he was respected and loved by all. He was active in the Georgia Chiropractic Association, serving as past Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors and as past District Two Director. He was board - eligible for Functional Neurology and was always expanding and sharing his knowledge of the human body, brain, and nervous system. He was a graduate of the University of South Carolina and Life University. When not with his patients, he enjoyed spending time in his woodland garden with his wife, Jan. He is also survived by brothers-in-law, Charles, Wayne, and Mike; along with sisters-in-law Carol and Mary Jane; all of whom loved him like a brother.
