“ From Lori:

Dear Family and Friends??As many of you have heard, Carl passed from this life and went to be with the Lord on November 4th 2014. We can't thank you enough for all the prayers that you have lifted up on Carl's and our family's behalf. We appreciate all the love, support, cards, flowers and food that you all have showered us with. For those who may not be familiar with the details of what we have been struggling with, Carl was diagnosed in September with Stage IV Peritoneal Mesothelioma. Mesothelioma is a rare cancer that is caused by exposure to asbestos. Carl did roofing work during the summers when he was in high school and college. At that time many construction materials including roofing tiles were laden with asbestos. Once asbestos fibers have been ingested, mesothelioma can take up to 60 years to develop and show symptoms in a person's body. By the time symptoms showed up in Carl, the cancer was already at an advanced stage.

Initial tests done on September 11th revealed that 50 – 60 percent of Carl's abdominal cavity contained cancerous tumors. Later tests revealed that the cancer had spread to the lymph nodes outside of the abdominal cavity. Treatment for this type of cancer would require very aggressive measures consisting of chemotherapy and multiple surgeries yet the overall prognosis would remain bleak. Carl was an eternally minded man. Instead of pursuing a gauntlet of medical treatments in order to buy a little more time here on earth, Carl decided to make some final deposits in the little time that he had left here on earth. He returned home to live and love his family.

Carl was an ordinary man who lived out his faith in an extraordinary way because he trusted God with his life and his death. He followed the footsteps of his Messiah with a genuine spirit of humility, joy, peace, gratitude and loving kindness toward others. In the midst of this great trial, these qualities in Carl did not diminish but they continued to grow stronger. Carl's faith and trust in the Lord never wavered and peace never left him. The love of God never ceased to flow from Carl and the light of God seemed to shine even brighter.

Carl's response to life has encouraged and touched the lives of many. He was a man who believed and had the courage to live out his beliefs. Carl lived with eternity in his heart. Our family is blessed beyond measure to have had Carl as our patriarch, husband, father, and friend. Carl will live on in our memories, thoughts and deeds. He has inspired us to trust God so that we live a life of gratitude, content in every circumstance. At this time, we pray for strength and await the joyous day when we are reunited with Carl in heaven. God is good.
