



## Glenn Albert Clonts

March 29, 1954 - April 26, 2015

Glenn Albert Clonts, 61, passed away unexpectedly on April 26, 2015, in Decatur, GA. He was preceded in death by his parents, Dr. Wilber T. and Leetimae Folds Clonts. He is survived by a sister, Viviann Clonts Bailey (Keith); three brothers, Wilber Clonts, Jr. (Esperanza), Charles Clonts (Sarah), and Paul Clonts (Jeanne); nephew Wilber Emmett Clonts, niece Emma Leetimae Clonts, and many cousins. Glenn was born and raised in Marietta. He attended Marietta High School where he excelled in football and other sports. He attended the University of Georgia for one year where he played football before transferring to Asbury College in Wilmore, KY. He earned a BS Degree in Mathematics and Biology and was a track and field standout. After his time at Asbury, Glenn took graduate courses at UGA before entering a graduate program in environmental engineering at Georgia Tech. Significant health problems forced him to discontinue his formal education and to limit his professional pursuits. For the following two decades, Glenn spent most of his time assisting and caring for his parents, particularly his chronically ill mother, even as he battled his own multiple health problems. His brothers and sister will be forever grateful to him for his years of service to our parents. Glenn's interests included playing guitar, following the Braves and the Falcons, learning about computer programming, gardening, and cooking. His courage and good nature in the face of so many health challenges over the years is something we will always admire. There will be a visitation at Mayes Ward-Dobbins on Saturday, May 2nd, from 12:30-2:00 p.m. immediately followed by a memorial service with Rev. Wayne Wiatt officiating. The family extends deepest gratitude to the doctors, pharmacists, and friends who supported Glenn through many difficult times.
