Ed chartered two banks, was president and CEO of three banks, and served in executive positions in seven banks. He was a charter member of Marietta Metro Rotary Club, Paul Harris Fellow, Past Chairman of Hospice, Former Board Member of the Kennesaw State University Foundation and Founding President of The KSU Alumni Society. Ed was active in the restoration of The Strand Theater, the formation of The Lockheed Aviation Museum and Habitat for Humanity.
