Nancy Sheffield Moor passed away on Sunday November 30, 2014. She was born in Atlanta, graduated from Southwest High School, attended West Georgia College, and graduated with honors from Georgia State University. She was a member of Marietta First United Methodist Church and the John Strother Sunday School Class.

Survivors include husband, Gregory B. Moor of Marietta; daughter, Heather Litterer of New York City; mother, Connie Sheffield; sister, Peggy Sheffield; and brother, Wendell Sheffield, all of Newnan.

Nancy had been clerk of the Georgia House of Representatives. She had also worked as national director of advertising and public relations for the Presbyterian Survey magazine. She later had her own advertising business. For the last twenty-four years, she had been employed at WellStar Health Place teaching water-based arthritis and hydro lite classes.

She was a wonderful mother and wife and was generous to her many friends. She battled many health issues but was known for her very positive and determined attitude which was an inspiration to all who knew her. Before her health issues she was an avid runner and ALTA tennis player. She enjoyed photography and world travel. Nancy was involved in numerous civic organizations including the Jaycettes, and most recently, Friends of the Georgia Symphony Orchestra.

A funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, December 8, 2014, at First United Methodist Church in Marietta with Dr. Sam Matthews officiating. Interment will follow at Kennesaw Memorial Park in Marietta. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service in the church parlor.
