



Patricia "Patti" Pearlberg

September 12, 1955 - August 23, 2018

Patricia (Patti) Pearlberg, age 62, of Marietta, Ga., passed away peacefully surrounded by her loving family in her home on Church Street on Thursday, August 23, 2018, after a long and very courageous battle with cancer.

Patti was born in Atlanta, Ga., on September 12, 1955 to the late Agnes and Don Lacy.

Patti graduated from Peachtree High School; the University of Georgia with a bachelor's degree; a Master's degree in Finance from Kennesaw State University and a Law degree from Georgia State University. Patti graduated with honors in each instance. At Georgia State University Law School, Patti was an Adjunct Professor in Real Estate Transactions.

Patti is survived by her husband Van, her son Scott Pearson (Kelly); her stepson Richard Pearlberg (Marci); two grandsons, Joey and Drew; her brother Michael Lacy (David Alfrey); sister Nancy Grieve (Scott); niece Lacy Benson (Preston) and nephew Michael Grieve.

Patti had over 30 years' experience in Commercial Real Estate and was the Chief Operating Officer/Managing Partner at Coro Reality Advisors, LLC.

Patti was a member of and served on numerous industry and community associations including CREW (Commercial Real Estate Women), ICSC (Int'l. Council of Shopping Centers), Cobb County Development Regulations, Council for Quality Growth, ULI-Urban Plan, Cobb Landmarks and Historical Society, the Woodruff Arts Center, the Cobb Symphony and past Chair of the Georgia Ballet. In 2013 Patti was honored as a Woman of Achievement by the NW Georgia YWCA and in 2014 received the Bisnow "Power Woman" award as one of the 40 most influential women in Atlanta Commercial Real Estate.

Patti loved entertaining, dancing, gardening; traveling, her family and her two Havanese dogs, Manolo Blahnik and Oscar De La Renta.
