Patrick Keith Price, 30, of Woodstock passed away suddenly from medical causes on September 29, 2015 and went on to the presence of the Lord.

The Funeral Service will be held Saturday at 2:00 p.m. at First Baptist Church of Woodstock. Interment will be held at Enon Cemetery in Woodstock.

Patrick was born in Marietta, on November 29, 1984 to Gene and Paula Price. He graduated from Lassiter High School and went on to receive a degree in Political Science from Kennesaw State University. Patrick and Brittany Brummel Price made their covenant vows to each other on July 9, 2011. In the year 2007, he served as an intern in the office of the Governor under Gov. Sonny Perdue and then went on to serve as a fellow. At the time of his passing, Patrick was the Strategic Planning, Initiatives and Innovations Coordinator for the State Board of Pardons and Paroles and a mandated Peace Officer. As a 5th grade Sunday School teacher at First Baptist Church of Woodstock, Patrick had the opportunity to mentor and disciple many children and continued to be a role model to them into their young adult lives. His life goal was to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ to as many people as possible.

Patrick is survived by his wife, Brittany; three young children--Peyton Keller, Evan Patrick, and Nathan Jude; his parents-- Gene and Paula Brown Price of Marietta; his sisters-- Laura Latham (Patrick), Kerry Gwinn (Scott); his grandparents--Sarah Price, and Paul and Peggy Brown; many nieces and nephews, as well as many extended family members.



I was one of the very first people he met when he started his career at the Parole Board and we clicked from that very first day. It used to make me so mad that such a young "kid" could teach me so much about life and how to live it in a Christlike manner but I would try to put aside my old pride to learn from him. He taught me that even as an authoritative figure in the lives of convicted criminals, I could also be caring and compassionate and that it was okay for me to show mercy and goodness to the people I was supervising. He made me want to give people the benefit of the doubt instead of being my "perfectly fine" jaded, judgmental self and he made me want to be a better person.....a person more like him, a person more like Jesus. I watched the way he dealt with people, which was almost always so calm and caring, and I listened to all of his ideas and suggestions about how things would work better if only we treated others the way we wished to be treated ourselves. For a long time I secretly admired him. I couldn't tell this young kid what an inspiration he was to me, an old timer, who had been on the job so much longer than he. My pride just wouldn't let me do it. So I began to pray that an opportunity would present itself wherein I would be compelled to tell him how much I admired him and how much I really wanted to be like him in so many ways and soon I got my chance. The details of that event are not really even important but when I started telling Patrick how I felt about him, my words just kept flowing until both of us were embarrassed. Because that is the kind of person Patrick was. He never understood why anyone wanted to be like him. He never understood what was so special about him. He never even thought there was anything special about him. He just went about his daily life serving God the best way he knew. His entire life was a shining example of a servant's heart and he thought nothing about it. That is just who he was. He didn't have to try because that is just who he was! I will never forget the day he showed me a picture of Brittany and said with the biggest smile on his face "I have a date with her. Why she would go out with me is a mystery but she said yes". And then in due time he showed me her ring and he was so nervous to ask for her hand in marriage because he still wondered why she would "settle" for him. They were the most beautiful and in love, Godly couple I know. Their precious little family meant everything to Patrick! Everything he did was for them! I am convinced that when Patrick took his last breath on Tuesday he still had no idea what a wonderful husband, father, son, grandson, uncle, brother, friend, etc... he was and how he impacted the lives of so many in so many ways.....because that was just Patrick. I have picked up the phone to call you so many times my friend and I am heartbroken and feel lost without you but I know you are with Jesus and I know that He has already told you that your time on Earth was a job well done!
